New Facility Environmental Permitting

- Hired Environmental Compliance Consulting Firm
- Oklahoma considerations:
 - Air emissions
 - Waste water discharges
 - Storm water discharges
 - Waste management (non-hazardous and/or hazardous)
 - SPCC planning
 - EPCRA reporting





New Facility Environmental Permitting (continued)

- Toxicity testing
 - Whole Effluent Toxicity (WET) testing:
 - Water Flea (C. dubia), reproduction and survival
 - Passed
 - Fathead Minnow, growth and survival
 - Passed
 - Respirometry to assess activated sludge impacts:
 - Passed





New Facility Environmental Permitting (continued)

TSCA submittals:

- Low Release and Low Exposure exemption (LoREx) approval from EPA for conditional manufacture of SW CNT materials (expires February 9, 2010).
- Pre-Manufacturing Notice (PMN) for SW CNT materials submitted to EPA on October 2, 2009.
- LoREx exemption notice for SMW CNT materials to be submitted to EPA by October 15, 2009.
