The applicant must submit a one-page abstract for a poster he or she proposes to present at the QEEN Workshop. Up to 10 abstracts may be selected to receive travel support. Eligibility Requirements

- The applicant must submit one-page abstract for a poster on engineered nanomaterials exposure research, to be presented at the QEEN Workshop, along with an itemized travel budget.
- Student or Postdoc must be registered and in good academic standing at an accredited academic institution.
