Top Eight Technology Transfer Lessons I Learned

(Assuming you don't want to become an entrepreneur)

- 8. Being better is not enough; technology must be more useful.
- 7. A patent is required; a *portfolio* of patents is necessary.
- 6. The more advanced the prototype, the better.
- 5. Your technology will not sell itself.
- Small companies have no money, mid-sized companies have their own technology, big companies buy small companies (not technology).
- 3. Successful technology transfer to a small company requires a committed partnership.
- 2. Be prepared to help your "child" move out of the house.
