

The 2nd Quantifying Exposure to Engineered Nanomaterials from Manufactured Products (QEEN II) Workshop

October 9-10, 2018

Conference Travel Support for Graduate Students and Postdoctoral Associates

Description

The organizing committee for the 2nd QEEN Workshop is pleased to provide travel assistance for a limited number of graduate students and postdoctoral associates to attend the meeting. Travel support will cover reimbursement of domestic travel, hotel, and per diem costs. Reimbursements will be made subject to U.S. Government travel regulations and restrictions. Applicants must submit an abstract for a poster he or she proposes to present at the QEEN II Workshop, along with an itemized travel budget.

The organizing committee will select recipients for travel support based primarily on its evaluation of the abstract submissions. The committee will evaluate applications based on the following criteria: relevance to the workshop theme areas, and potential to advance the scientific value of the meeting. Where contributions are of equal merit, the organizing committee will strive to support researchers in diverse areas and subdisciplines, and with a broad geographic distribution. Priority will also be given to applicants who did not receive support for QEEN I. Up to 10 students and postdocs may be selected to receive travel support.

Eligibility Requirements

- The applicant must submit an abstract (500-word maximum).
- Applicants must be either graduate students or postdoctoral associates registered and in good academic standing at an accredited academic institution in the United States.

Abstract submissions are due **by midnight August 1, 2018**. Applicants receiving travel support will be notified by **September 1, 2018**.
